Result of Surveillance Visit

Based on the *Report of Second Surveillance Visit of Selangor FMU for Forest Management Certification* [Ref: F122_248 dated 20 August 2004], the remaining outstanding CAR (SEL-005) was closed out. However, one new Minor CAR (SEL-015) relating to the planning and harvesting of forest plantation was raised.

As the new Minor CAR raised does not preclude certification, and based on the recommendation of SGS, MTCC has maintained the validity of the *Certificate for Forest Management*.

A summary of the CARs raised is as shown in **Table 1**.
