**Result of Surveillance Visit**

Base on the *Report of Third Surveillance Visit of Selangor FMU for Forest Management Certification* [Ref: F122\_262 dated 15 November 2005], the single Minor CAR for Selangor FMU i.e. SEL-015 was maintained as the Selangor FMU has made progress but not yet fully address the Minor CAR.

As no new Major CAR was raised, SGS has recommended that the *Certification for Forest Management* issued to the FMU be maintained. However, the Selangor FMU is required to take necessary action to address the outstanding Minor CAR before the next surveillance visit.

A summary of the Minor CAR raised is as shown in **Table 1**.
